## You can speak to us in confidence

We won't share what you tell us with anyone, without your consent. We will only disclose illegal activity and safeguarding concerns to the relevant authority.

### You stay in control

We won't tell you what to do. We will simply help you and your neighbour decide what should happen next. That way, everyone is more likely to stick to the agreements.

#### What to expect

We will contact you and your neighbour individually to establish all the concerns.



We will help you to understand each other's point of view and reach agreements to resolve the concerns. This may involve a meeting for everyone to attend or communicating by speaking through us. You do not have to meet with your neighbour face to face.



We will continue to support you as we monitor the agreements.
